Re: Harbort permits for the construction of docks
in the Marshallberg Boat Basin, Marshallberg,
Carteret County, North Carolina

Dear Mr. Hamilton:

Enclosed with this letter are six (6) copies and the original of drawings for the submission to the Army Corps of Engineers at Wilmington in order to obtain permits for the construction of boat berths and the accompanying docks or walkways for the North Side of the Boat Basin. These docks will be as indicated along the shore line of the Neal property.

Mr. Ralph Neal has agreed to issue the necessary permits for the use of his land, or shore line, upon the approval of the Army Corps of Engineers. The drawings have been signed by those requesting these berths, and whose boats at the present time are either anchored at the location or are on the opposite South Side.

I have offered to assist the owners of the other boats in the Harbor or Basin to draw up the necessary drawings for submission to the Army Corps of Engineers upon their obtaining the necessary permits from the owners on the opposite side or South Side of the Basin; but as yet have not been notified of their obtaining such from the owners on the property. The owners of the boats who would like to erect the proper type construction docks on the South side need the permission I receive from the Jackson land as indicated on the overall Harbor plan; the other owners I am quite confident do not have any objection to the erection of docks on this South side.

I trust that the enclosed drawings will be satisfactory for submission to the Army Corps of Engineers at Wilmington. I might add that it is contemplated by the boat owners on the South side to head their boats in to the shore instead of running them parallel as on the North shore. Only the permission of the property owners is needed to solve this harbor problem of boat space on the South Side.
